

Use of E-Resource by Law Students in Library, Amity University, Gwalior (M.P.): A Study.

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ABSTRACT

The present study has been based on the various e-resources of Amity Law School, Amity University, Gwalior. This library has been providing in various e-resources for AIR (All India Reporter), SCC (Supreme Court Cases), Manupatra and Delnet. This study was conducted by BA LLB, BBA LLB, B.COM LLB, and LLM students. A questionnaire was prepared to take the opinion of the law students, and this study was limited only Amity Law School. This study checks the status of awareness and satisfaction of providing various e-resources in the Amity Law School Library, Amity University, Gwalior.

Background of Amity University, Gwalior:-

Amity University¹ is a very good university of private origination and better than another. Amity University has been established 2010 by a Madhya Pradesh act no. 27 of 2010 of the government of M.P., and is recognized as per section 2 (f) of the UGC Act. This university sponsored by the Ritnand Balved Education Foundation (RBEF) New Delhi with the society registered under of societies registration act of 1860. It was established with the view to promote professional industry-oriented education in the state of Madhya Pradesh. The university locates of 110 acres of land opposite Gwalior airport, will import of modern practices and research-based courses. Amity University imparts education in almost all areas including Law, Management, Engineering, Biotechnology, Law, Communication, Pharmacy, Nanotechnology, Behavioral Science, Fine Arts etc.

About the Law Library and Central Library, Amity University, Gwalior:-

The Amity University² library is a nice collection in the library. The Library is seven departmental libraries and with Central Library. The collection of central library 30978 books, 15256 e-journals, 75 print journals, 25 magazines, 556 CD, and ALS departmental library collection like 3439 books, 12 print journals, four e- databases (AIR(All India Reporter), SCC (Supreme

Court Cases), Manupatra, and Delnet), 4 magazines, 162 CD at the Amity Law School library, open 09:00 AM to 08:00 PM. The ALS Departmental library provides for various AIR (All India Reporter), SCC (Supreme Court Cases), Manupatra and Delnet.

Objectives of the study:-

The objectives of the present study in using e-resources for law students at Amity University, Gwalior.

- To know the awareness of e-resources of the law students of the ALS Departmental Library, Amity University, Gwalior.
- To know the use of e-resources for AIR (All India Reporter), SCC (Supreme Court Cases) Manupatra and Delnet.
- To know the satisfaction of using various e-resources of law students.

Review of literature:-

1. **Sharma, Chetan (2016)**³ This study is described the availability of e-resources in a university library are very common today. But in this paper limit of using e-resources, is a point of discussion. The present paper examines the existence of various e-resource databases in Guru Govind Singh Indraprastha University library. The study also highlights the preferences and the importance of online resources among the faculty and research scholar students.
2. **Usha, S. Kulal and Ramesh A.P.(2017)**⁴ this study focuses on the role of information Communication Technology for accessing e-resources by the research scholars, faculty members and under graduate students in Shri Madhwa Vadiraja Institute of Technology & Management, Bantakal. Investigator has adopted survey method for collecting data through well-structured questionnaires. The questions were randomly distributed among 250 users and 225 (75 from research scholars and 150 from students) valid samples were collected. The analysis of collected data declares the role of internet and how e-resources are accessing by the effective use of information communication technology, how electronic e-resources are enlightening the research work, academic carriers of the faculty members and students and also what problems are being faced at the time of using the information communication technology.
3. **Maharana, Balu, and Sethi, Bipin Bihari (2018)**⁵ studied describe basic of library services on the internet and electronic resources have become most of popular sources of information for the students, research scholar, faculties and professionals. The present study was designed to find out the usage of internet and e-resource by the library users for all categories of the master's courses in Business administration at Sambalpur University, Orissa. This study total questionnaire 120 for the MBA students, out of which 91(75.83%) responded to this survey the present investigation gives an indication of the range of uses of internet and E-resources by MBA students.
4. **Sinha, Manoj Kumar and Singha, Gaugi (2018)**⁶ the study was discribe of Assam university, Silchar. This study focus on library services of the university library. The library provided many services for users. The study focus very important service for e-resource services In the Assam university library, Silchar. An electronic resource made available in the Assam university library under the Ugc-Infonet e-journals/ Digital Library consortium of Ugc-Inlibnet amongst the research scholar and facility members northeast region of India. The facilities, students and research scholar are mainly drowned from purpose survey method has been adopted by the investigation, which comprises of administration of the questionnaire, observation, and interview of some of the participants.

Research Methodology:-

The present study, Using of e-resource for Law Students in the Amity University, was conducted through questionnaire methods for data collection. A total of 100 questionnaires was distributed and were obtained only 80 filled questionnaires from the students. Out of 80 questionnaires, only 75 (93.75%) questionnaires were selected for data analysis and 5 (6.25%)

questionnaire was rejected because of incomplete response received from the respondents. In the study have been asking of the different types questions for related to e-resources. The secondary data has been collected from annual reports, University newsletter, university library, brochures, and website, etc.

Scope of the study:-

The scope of the study is confined to the only BA LLB, BBA LLB, B.COM LLB, and LLM students of Amity Law School Library Members, Amity University (AUMP) Gwalior.

Limitations of the study:-

The limitation of the study is only Law students in Amity Law School, a departmental library of the Amity University (AUMP), Gwalior. This study is not included in other schools/ institute/branch/ stream of the Amity University (AUMP), Gwalior.

Data Sample:-

Data collection forms the questionnaires were analyzed using frequency counts and simple percentage. There are a large number of user's and these ranges from undergraduates and postgraduate students BA LLB (30), BBA LLB (30), B.COM LLB (20), and LLM (20) a sample form all categories of the user have taken to find out their opinion about as below given the categories of users.

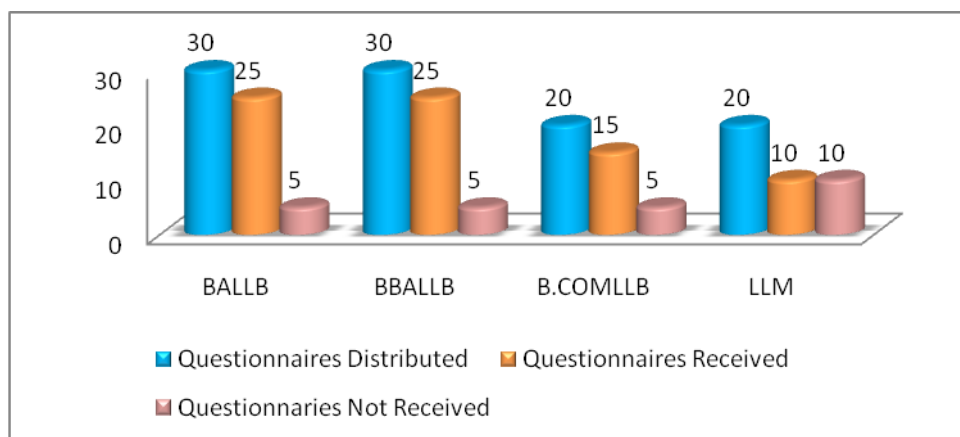
Data Analysis and Interpretation:-

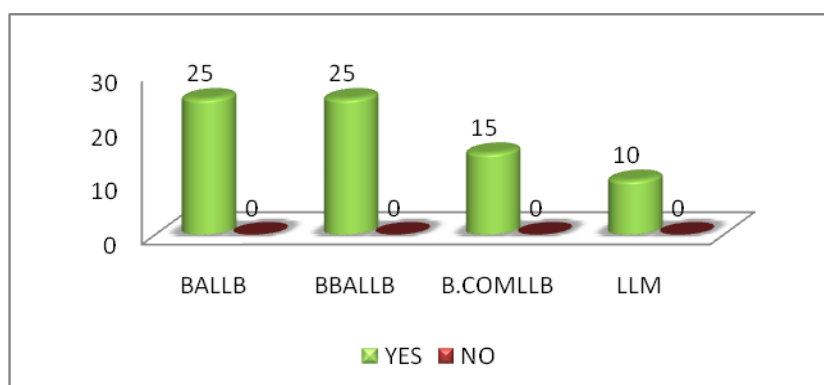
Graph No. 1 Respondents of all Library Users

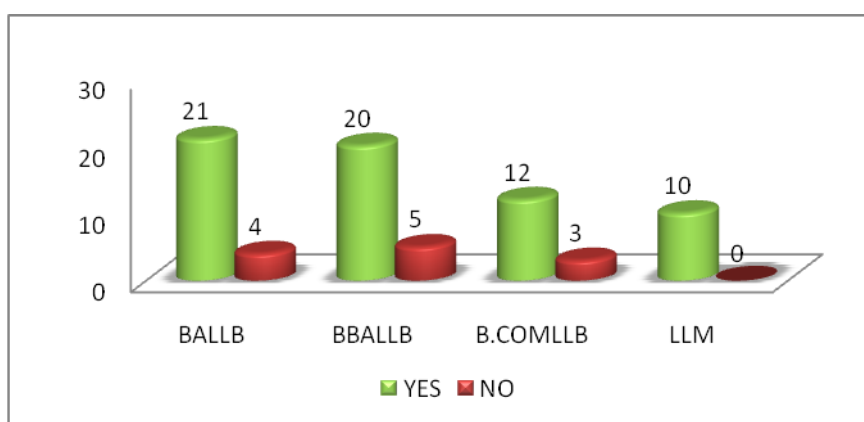
Graph No. 2 Awareness and Familiarity with AIR

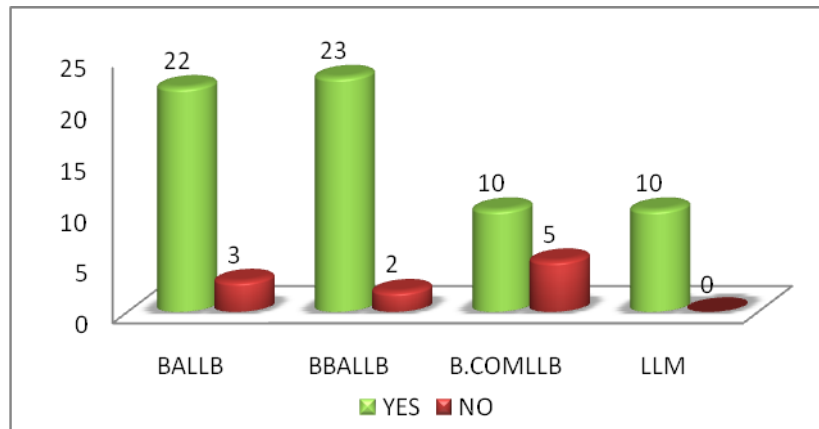
Graph No.3 Awareness and Familiarity with SCC

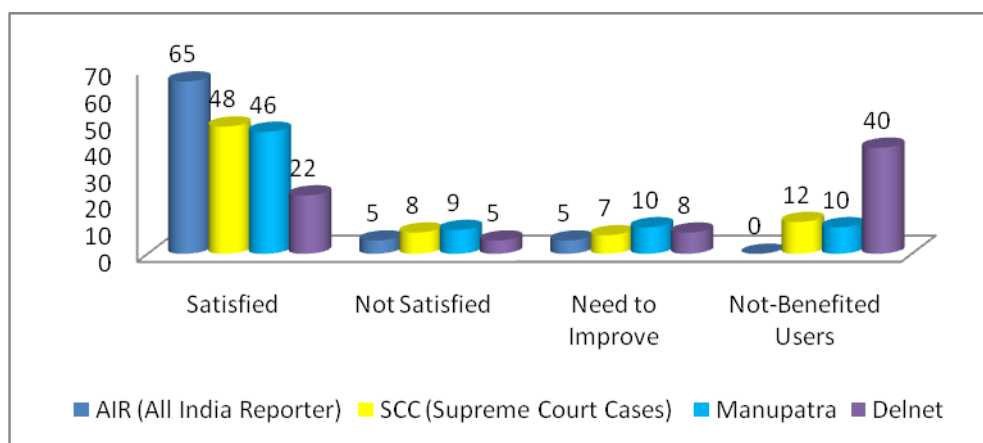
Graph No. 5 Awareness and Familiarity with Delnet

Recommendations: -

- It has been observed that the use of SCC (Supreme Court Cases) resource is not done properly by the users, and that few users are not aware of this resource.

It is recommended that the awareness program should be provided to use the SCC resource.

- It has been observed that the use of Delnet resource is not done properly by the users, and that mostly users are not aware of this resource.

It is recommended that the awareness program should be provided to use the Delnet resource.
