Term 'consortia' was used first time in the North American library lexicon in the 1960. And it means form of structured cooperation focused primarily on resource sharing and cost reduction. In some European countries, use of the term 'consortia' in library contexts has very remote origin.

In the beginning, consortia focused on Inter Library Loan (ILL) and document delivery service based on union catalogues and locally held resources. Retrospective conversion and preservation initiatives followed. Today, emphasis is on buying, cooperatives, influencing policy, specifically scholarly publication pattern, research and development to improve content delivery and standard for developing and managing collection often through grants, and expanding access to specialized resources. Meaning of Library Consortia - A library consortia is a concept which facilitates the libraries to get the benefit of winder access to electronic resources at affordable cost and at the best terms of licenses. Group of libraries come together with common interest to form consortium. One of the libraries or agencies will work as coordinator for identification of libraries for each publisher, legal matter etc. The aim of consortia is to achieve what the members of group cannot achieve individually.
