To keep ownership, domain names must be renewed regularly. They might become accessible for registration by others if they are not renewed.
- **Hosting Plan:** The service that enables people or businesses to make their websites available online is known as website hosting. The web hosting company provides the space necessary to keep the files, data, and other content that you create for a website. For choosing any hosting plan first the following factors have to be considered:
 - ✓ website's requirements,
 - ✓ expected traffic,
 - ✓ technical expertise, and
 - ✓ budget.

- Contact Information.

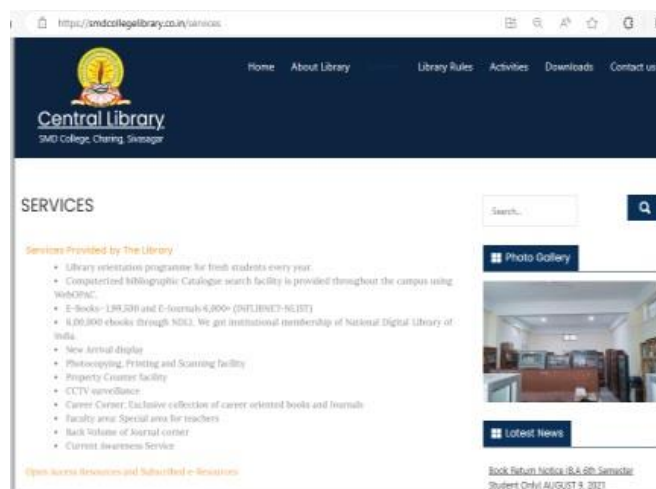


Image : View of SMD College Library website
